## STANDARD SHOOTING USE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- **1.** ("RPR") is available for use by all RPR Members, Guests of Members, private citizen groups and by the general public. RPR Memberships are available to provide preferred access, services and facility use, and other benefits. RPR Range Membership and day use is subject to the Standard Shooting Terms and Conditions stated herein. Membership will be granted, and may be revoked, at the sole discretion of RPR.
- **2.** As part of the consideration for Membership, the Member hereby agrees to pay an annual membership fee of which includes the benefits and privileges of membership for a period of 1 year from the date of payment.
- **4.** All Members, guests, and other RPR facility users must obey the RPR Range rules and must review, agree to the terms of, and sign the Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement. Furthermore, all members, guests, and other RPR facility users must participate in the RPR range safety and orientation course before shooting at the range.
- **5.** All guests of members must be accompanied by the member to be admitted to the firing line. Members are responsible for all actions taken by their guests and will hold RPR harmless for property damage, accidents and injuries to or caused by guests.
- **6.** All Members and guests are subject to the general policies and rules of operation and administration of RPR, all of which are intended to provide a safe, professional, friendly and family-oriented club.
- **7.** Any member or guest of a member may be suspended or expelled from the range and/or facility for violation of the Range Rules or for behavior deemed unsafe by RPR personnel.
- **9.** A membership may be unilaterally terminated by RPR if, in the sole discretion of RPR management, the conduct of a member or the member's guest presents a safety hazard. In the event a Membership is terminated by RPR for violations of agreed upon Terms and Conditions or Range Rules, the membership fee will not be refunded.
- **10.** Any destruction of RPR property caused by a member or a member's guest, whether accidental, negligent, willful or otherwise, may result in the violator being removed from the range and/or facility, suspended or removed from membership if a member, and/or criminally prosecuted. In addition, RPR reserves the right to assess to the member a reasonable charge for any such damage, regardless of whether the damage is caused by the member or the member's guest.

- 12. All members and guests must present a current photo ID in order to access the range.
